## Romans 2:1-11

<sup>1</sup>Therefore you have no excuse, whoever you are, when you judge others; for in passing judgement on another you condemn yourself, because you, the judge, are doing the very same things.

<sup>2</sup>You say, 'We know that God's judgement on those who do such things is in accordance with truth.'

<sup>3</sup>Do you imagine, whoever you are, that when you judge those who do such things and yet do them yourself, you will escape the judgement of God?

<sup>10</sup>but glory and honour and peace for everyone who does good, the Jew first and also the Greek.

<sup>11</sup>For God shows no partiality.
