# The Bible Doesn't Say Christians Can't Have Demons

*by Rev. David Fisher*

*2 Corinthians 11:1-6*



Christian Fellowship Church has been chosen by God to be a healthy-healing Church that God will use to plant, root and grow people up in faith, love and in His healing grace.

People of different church denominations, especially the Catholic Church, observe All Saints' Day throughout Canada on November 1<sup>st</sup>. In the Roman Catholic Church, "All Saints Day" is officially known as the Solemnity of All Saints and is called All Hallows or Halloween. The evening before is known as All Hallows Eve or, popularly, as Halloween. Halloween has strong roots in the Celtic festival of Samhain that celebrates the end of the "lighter half" of the year and beginning of the "darker half". Sometimes known as the "Celtic New Year", the festival of Samhain featured dressing up in costumes to scare off harmful spirits. While Halloween's imagery is derived from numerous sources, its connection to divination, having been practiced at the festival of Samhain, and other occult practices is unmistakable.

<sup>2</sup>I am jealous for you with a godly jealousy. I promised you to one husband, to Christ, so that I might present you as a pure virgin to him.

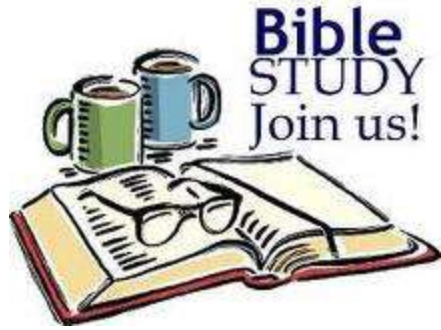
