## Philippians 2:1-11 (NIV)

### Imitating Christ's Humility

<sup>1</sup> Therefore if you have any encouragement from being united with Christ, if any comfort from his love, if any common sharing in the Spirit, if any tenderness and compassion, <sup>2</sup> then make my joy complete by being like-minded, having the same love, being one in spirit and of one mind. <sup>3</sup> Do nothing out of selfish ambition or vain conceit. Rather, in humility value others above yourselves, <sup>4</sup> not looking to your own interests but each of you to the interests of the others.

<sup>5</sup> In your relationships with one another, have the same mindset as Christ Jesus:

<sup>6</sup> Who, being in very nature God, did not consider equality with God something to be used to his own advantage;

<sup>7</sup> rather, he made himself nothing by taking the very nature of a servant, being made in human likeness.

<sup>8</sup> And being found in appearance as a man, he humbled himself by becoming obedient to death—even death on a cross!

<sup>9</sup> Therefore God exalted him to the highest place and gave him the name that is above every name,

<sup>10</sup> that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, in heaven and on earth and under the earth,

<sup>11</sup> and every tongue acknowledge that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.

## **VACANT COORDINATOR POSITIONS**

We have a number of coordinator positions available. Please consider praying and nominating someone who would be an excellent candidate for the position.

### ***Children & Youth Ministry Coordinator***

The individual in this position will be responsible for prayer and support of all those involved in the provision of Christian Education towards children and youth at Christian Fellowship Church; assuring as much as possible all who give and receive Christian education through the church do so in a safe & caring environment. Working together with the Sunday school instructors, determine what the Christian education needs are and develop plans for those needs. This position is accountable to CFC's Leadership Board and monthly reports are required. The individual in this position will be responsible for the tracking of his/her budget.

### ***Missions & Outreach Coordinator***

The individual in this position will be responsible for working closely with existing outreach programs and missions. To develop new programs of outreach, to recruit and disciple helpers as deemed necessary. To coordinate discipleship programs for personal and corporate evangelism. To help instill a vision for outreach and present goals and programs to the congregation. This individual is also responsible for Visitor follow-up. This position is accountable to CFC's Leadership Board and monthly reports are required. The individual in this position will be responsible for the tracking of his/her budget.

### ***Small Groups Coordinator***

The individual in this position will be responsible for coordination of all bible-study groups for youth, care groups, mens, ladies and senior groups as well as new member discipleship groups. You are to encourage inter and intra group communication, prayer and mutual strengthening. You are also to oversee group doctrine with the Pastor to ensure that group leaders are adequately qualified, prepared, and have adequate materials. This position is accountable to CFC's Leadership Board and monthly reports are required. The individual in this position will be responsible for the tracking of his/her budget.
