“Provision After Priorities”

Scripture: Matthew 6:7-14



Christian Fellowship Church has been chosen by God to be a healthy-healing Church that God will use to plant, root and grow people up in faith, love and in His healing grace.

Becoming aware of the Kingdom of God – as differentiated from the kingdom of this world means hearing God’s voice and moving in the Holy Spirit. The prayer Jesus taught his disciples began with relationship, that is they addressed God as Father. Next it speaks of doing His will, “your Kingdom come your will be done”. It then asks for a Father’s provision, “give us this day our daily bread”. Thus, our relationship with God comes first, next our priorities are synchronized with God’s priorities, then and only then do we ask for God’s provision. The order shapes the identity of Jesus’ disciples. Disciples are children in the family of God first, not beggars. Disciples receive God’s provision, not to squander it for individual use, but to bless with the blessings we have received. God’s provision this is a tangible expression of our Father’s heart of love to us and through us to the world around us. -DF.
